A RESOLUTION

That not to exceed \$4,000 or as much thereof as may be needed or Tribal funds, Individual Indian Moneys Account of the Fort Arache Indian Agency, be alletted to the Supt. for salaries and expenses in the development of range water supply in cooperation with the CCC-ID projects where such projects are seriously needed to take advantage of the grazing in areas where water within reasonable distances is not available.

The foregoing resolution was on January 9, 1939 duly adopted, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by section 1.
