

A RESOLUTION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special session on this date April 19, 1939 that:

The Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby authorized to collect all revenue of every description accruing to the White Mountain Apache Tribe from any source whatsoever, such as mining leases, grazing permits, fishing and hunting permits, sale of livestock, timber, etc.

The foregoing resolution was on April 19, 1939, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1-43, Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 948).
