

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS: The Secretary of the Interior under date of April 13, 1939, approved the establishment and operation of a Tribal Buying and selling Enterprise and authorized the use of Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.) dollars in this activity, and -

Whereas: Applications for the use of these funds in the construction of Indian homes and the purchasing of materials for sale to Individuals reveals that the original amount authorized is insufficient to take care of all the urgent needs for which applications are filed,


THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED; That in order to provide industrial assistance to the members of our Tribe, The Tribal Council in regular session this 2nd day of October, 1939, under authority of its Constitution and bylaws hereby authorizes the use of an additional Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.) dollars, and requests the Secretary of the Interior to make the additional amount available from funds belonging to the White Mountain Apache Tribe and deposited as "Proceeds of Labor, Fort Apache Indians, Arizona (Industrial Assistance, Reimbursable, for the financing of the enterprise.
