EMERAS: the Lessee, Louis A Kushne now desires to Assign said Lesse in accordance with the provisions of Section 26 (a) of the "Rules Coverning the Lessing of Tribal Lands for Mining Purposes", (25 U.S.C. 186.26 (a)0), and has executed an Assignment on the prescribed forms, in favor of Mesers A. L. Lampton and Hollis B. Gruy, of Globe, Arizons, who have executed the "ACCEPTANCE MY ASSIGNANT, of aforesaid Assignment,

MON THEREFOR ME IT RESOLVED: by the Tribal Council that the Assignment of Mining Lease be and is hereby approved.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted this 17th, day of May, 1940 by a vote of Sor and against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 1 (e), Article VI, of the Constitution and Ry-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 14, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
