RESOLUTION

Be it resolved by the Council of the Waite Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 14th day of July, 1941, that:

- WHEREAS, it is within the powers of the Tribal Council to submit to the Department of the Interior, recommendations for the expenditure of gratuity and tribal funds for tribal support, reservation improvements, and other necessary activities looking towards the advancement of the members of the tribe, and
- WHEREAS, there has been prepared an "Advance Estimate of proposed expenditures" for the fiscal year 1945, which we have carefully examined and considered in connection with the actual needs of our resorvation, insofar as it is possible to determine our requirements in advance, and composed of the following aggregate sums:

GRATUITY APPROPRIATIONS	133.576
TRUST FUEDS (Tribal)	68.708
OTHER TRUST FUNDS	17.700
ROADS INDIAN RESERVATIONS	52.766
SOIL & MOISTURE CONSERVATION OPERATIONS	13,682

AND WHEREAS, the details or analysis of proposed expenditures are more accurately set forth in the attached "Advance Estimate", which represents the amounts to be used as shown above.

MOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Interior be requested to approve and the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby recommends and approves the Advance Estimate for the Fiscal Year 194 3, as herewith presented.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1941, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (6) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
