

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 4th day of May, 1942 that:

WHEREAS, it is within the powers of the Tribal Council to submit to the Department of the Interior, recommendations for the expenditure of gratuity and tribal funds for tribal support, reservation improvements and other necessary activities looking toward the advancement of the members of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, there has been prepared an Advance Estimate of proposed expenditures for the fiscal year 1943 of the Individual Indian Moneys, White Mountain Apache Tribal Account, which we have carefully examined and considered in connection with the actual needs of our Reservation, insofar as it is possible to determine our requirements in advance, and composed of the following sums:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior be requested to approve and the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby recommends and approves the above estimate for the Fiscal Year 1943 as herewith presented.

The foregoing resolution was on May 4th, 1942, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (5) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
