

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this date February 7, 1944 that:

WHEREAS, the Tribe has on deposit in the Individual Indian Money Account approximately \$90,000, which fund is not needed for general administrative or tribal purposes and

WHEREAS, this is not at present an interest bearing fund and the money is needed by the Federal Government for defense purposes and the tribe is willing to cooperate with the Federal Government in the purchase of bonds,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs request the Secretary of the Interior to approve the purchase for the White Mountain Apache Tribe a total of \$100,000 of Series E or G bonds during the present and next fiscal year as Tribal Funds permit. All bonds are to be registered in the name of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 7, 1944, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 14, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
