RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe
in regular session this date May 1, 1944 that:

An allotment from the fund Individual Indian Moneys, in the
amount of \$1,000, be made for the purpose of supplying funds
for forest-fire protection or suppression activities within
the forest and range lands of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was this 1st day of May, 1944 duly adopted
by a vote of _____ for and _____ against by the Tribal Council of the
White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by
Section 1 (d), Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe,
ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary
of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
