

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

No. 134

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 7th day of May, 1945, that:


WHEREAS, it is within the powers of the Tribal Council to submit to the Department of the Interior, recommendations for the expenditure of gratuity and tribal funds for tribal support, reservation improvements and other necessary activities looking toward the advancement of the members of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, there has been prepared an advanced estimate of proposed expenditures for the fiscal year 1946 of the Individual Indian Money, White Mountain Apache Tribal Account, which we have carefully examined and considered in connection with the actual needs of our Reservation insofar as it is possible to determine our requirements in advance, and composed of the following sums:

1. Salaries (Judge of Indian Court) - - - - -	900.00
2. Per diem Councilmen- - - - -	900.00
3. Stationary and other miscellaneous expenses- - - - -	600.00
4. AAA Water Development- - - - -	1200.00
5. Relief for old folks - - - - -	12000.00
6. Round up wild horses - - - - -	1500.00
7. Tribal Clerk - - - - -	1800.00
8. Care of Club Building, Janitor, etc. - - - - -	1200.00
TOTAL- - - - -	<u>20100.00</u>

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior be requested to approve and the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby recommends and approves the above estimate for the Fiscal Year 1946 as herein presented.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 7, 1945, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




Chairman of the Tribal Council
