

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

**No. 135**

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 7th day of May, 1945 that:

**WHEREAS**, it is within the powers of the tribal council to submit to the department of the Interior the recommendations for the expenditure of tribal funds for tribal support, reservation improvements and other necessary activities having to do with the support and the advancement of the tribe and its individual members, and

**WHEREAS**, the tribe is operating what is known as the Old Folks' Herd which herd is used for the production of beef and support of the old and indigent members and for the production of high grade tribal bulls to place on the various sections of the reservation with individual Indian cattle and for the production of high grade heifers to issue to younger members of the tribe as they come to maturity and as is determined by the tribal council and its administration to place these heifers annually with members eligible and entitled to same on a reimbursable repayment plan whereby the members eligible and entitled to same on a reimbursable repayment plan whereby the members receiving these cattle will reimburse the Old Folks Herd for these cattle in the usual manner.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND RECOMMEND** that the following expenses for the operation of this herd be approved and that the Secretary of the Interior advance to the Superintendent for the fiscal year, 1946, the total amount of \$19,978.00 or as much thereof as may be necessary to carry on the above activity.

1. Stock salt - - - - -	278.00
2. Alfalfa hay - - - - -	5000.00
3. Cotton seed cake - - - - -	4000.00
4. Horse shoes - - - - -	150.00
5. Barbed wire, stay wire, staples, etc. - - - - -	300.00
6. Veterinary supplies including blackleg, etc. - - - - -	200.00
7. Cats for stock work - - - - -	1800.00
8. Round-up supplies for stock work and breeding plant - - - - -	700.00
9. Wages for round up and irregular labor on stock work and breeding plant - - - - -	6000.00
10. Cost of labor in producing ensilage and hay locally on Agency farm - - - - -	1000.00
11. Salary of laboratory technician at breeding plant - - - - -	550.00
12. Registering hereford calves - - - - -	200.00
<b>TOTAL - - - - -</b>	<b>19978.00</b>

The foregoing Resolution was on May 7, 1945, duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution by-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 18 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
