

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session on this 7th day of May, 1945 that:

The Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby authorized to sell permits for fishing within the reservation under rules and regulations as heretofore compiled and in effect and in accordance with other rules and regulations that it may be necessary to enforce from time to time to protect the interests of the reservation. All fees collected from the sale of permits are to be deposited to the credit of the White Mountain Apache Tribe as Individual Indian Money, Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing Resolution was on May 7, 1945 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Fort Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 Article 0 Paragraphs P of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
