## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 6th day of May, 1946, that:

WHEREAS, there has been prepared on advanced estimate of proposed expenditures for the fiscal year 1946 of the Individual Indian Money, White Mountain Apache Tribal Account, which we have carefully examined and considered in connection with the actual needs of our Reservation insofar as it is possible to determine our requirements in advance, and composed of the following sums:

The foregoing Resolution was on May 6, 1946, duly adopted by a vete of 10 fer and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Meuntain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
