

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in session held this 29th day of July 1946, that:

WHEREAS, the contract between the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., and the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation, approved July 19, 1943 provides "that the Secretary of the Interior in his discretion and with the consent of the Tribal Council may relieve the purchaser in whole or in part from the minimum cutting and paying requirements because of adverse market conditions, fire damage to the Purchaser's manufacturing plant, or acts of God or Government Control," and

WHEREAS, the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., failed to meet the minimum cutting requirement for the year ending March 31, 1946 on the Maverick Timber Unit covered by Contract approved July 19, 1943, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council does feel that since the purchaser has so far failed to meet the minimum requirements of the contract and therefore has deprived the tribe of funds which it would have received had the purchaser complied with the cutting requirements of the Contract,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., be relieved of the cutting requirements for the year ending March 31, 1946 and the paying requirements EXCEPT in the amount of Five Thousand (\$5,000) Dollars, which amount shall be deposited with the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency and held as Special Deposits until such time as the Southwest Lumber Mills, Inc., shall meet the minimum cutting requirements, after which the deposit of \$5,000 shall be applied on timber cut, as provided in the contract.

The foregoing Resolution was this 29th day of July 1946 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Authority vested in it by Section III of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 16, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
