

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in session this 29th day of July, 1946, that:

WHEREAS, there have been several requests to purchase the timber of the Forestdale Timber Unit within the Corduroy Working Circle.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that sale of the Timber of the Corduroy Working Circle is hereby authorized providing the net volume of timber sold shall not exceed that authorized by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs.

The foregoing Resolution was this 29th day of July 1946 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to Authority vested in it by Section 1 (c), Article VI of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
