RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF T'E FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mrs. Earl West has, since the year 1937, been using a range area mm bounded on the east by Highway 60, on the west by Snake Ridge, on the south by a drift fence north of the mouth of the Cotton-wood Canyon and on the north by the Reservation Boundary, and
- WHEREAS, this said range area, previous to 1937, was used for grazing Indian Association cattle, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian Association cattle on adjoining districts have so increased in number that their present range is over-atilized to a degree that either additional range must be acquired or their eattle reduced.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 9th day of September, 1946, that the privilege of using this said range area, granted to Mrs. Earl West in 1937 by Superintendent Demner, be revoked and that this said range area be returned to its original status as Indian Association cattle range, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mrs. Earl West move her cattle from this said range to her original range area at a date not later than January 1, 1947, and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mrs. Earl West shall not stock her original range beyond the established carrying capacity of said range.

The foregoing resolution was on September 9, 1946, duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 16,1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1954 (48 Stat. 984).
