RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

E" IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arisona, this 14th day of October, 1946, that there is hereby authorised to be set aside the following described land:

Lying within the boundaries of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, the unsurveyed Townsite of McNary, Apache County, Arisona, and Section 19, Township 3 North, Range 24 Rast of the Gila and Salt River Moridan. Three Hundred and Minety feet North along the center line of McCaffey Street, from the intersection of Oak Street to the point of beginning; thence East 150.0 feet to the SE Corner; thence 500.00 feet North to the NE Corner; thence 400.0 feet West to the NW Corner; thence South 500.0 feet to the SW Corner; thence 250.0 feet East to the point of beginning, containing 4.59 acres, more or less,

for use and occupancy as a school reserve for as long as such land is used for school purposes in the construction or improvement of school facilities in cooperation by the Secretary of the Interior with the McNary School District, Apache County, Arisons.


This resolution is the consent of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, Arisona, required by the Interior Appropriation Act for the fiscal year 1947 as a condition precedent to the Secretary of the Interior to set aside tribal land at McNary, Arisona, to be used as a school reserve, as provided for in that act.

The foregoing resolution was on October 14, 1946, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Lame of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
