## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE PORT APACHE RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 168 dated July 29, 1946, provided for the payment of salaries of the forest fire lockouts for fiscal year 1948 be made from tribal funds appropriated by Congress, and

WHEREAS, The Office of Indian Affairs has recommended that these salaries be paid from tribal funds on deposit to the credit of the White Hountain Apache Tribe in an individual Indian Momey Account at the Agency, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribs that the sum of \$6000 is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit to the credit of the Tribs for salaries of forest fire lookouts for the 1947 fire season, such salaries to be paid in accordance with the salary schedules for the classified positions heretofore established, and such positions to remain a part of the Forestry and Grasing Division as in the past.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on December 2, 1965, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in Article VI, Section 1(d) of the constitution and By-lass of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
