

SECTION 10
THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE RESERVATION

Resolved, that appropriated funds for needed drugs and supplies for the Fort Apache Hospital are not sufficient for the needs for the balance of the fiscal year and since additional drugs and supplies are necessary for medication of Indian patients,

that by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the expenditure of not to exceed \$800.00 for purchasing drugs and other hospital supplies needed before June 30, 1947, from Tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency is hereby authorized.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1947 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article XI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 24, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 10, 1934 (48 Stat. 948).
