RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 4th day of May, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, certain permanent improvements and facilities are necessary at the I. D. Ranch and Breeding Plant,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following repairs, improvements and additional facilities, in accordance with the following estimates, are hereby approved:

Plumbing and Repairs - Breeding Plant	100.00
Gravel for pens at Breeding Plant	500.00
Oil Stoves and fixtures at I. D. Ranch	400.00
Construction of Bunk House at Breeding Plant	1000.00
Light Plant and wiring for I. D. Ranck	800.00
Water pipe and equipment I. D. Bunkhouse	300.00
Cosspool I. D. Ranch	300.00
Total	\$3400.00

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on May 5th, 1947, by a vote of for and against by the Tribal Council of the White Meuntain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
