

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 4th day of May, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, certain permanent improvements and facilities are necessary at the I. D. Ranch and Breeding Plant,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following repairs, improvements and additional facilities, in accordance with the following estimates, are hereby approved:

Plumbing and Repairs - Breeding Plant - - - - -	\$	100.00
Gravel for pens at Breeding Plant - - - - -		500.00
Oil Stoves and fixtures at I. D. Ranch - - - - -		400.00
Construction of Bunk House at Breeding Plant - - -		1000.00
Light Plant and wiring for I. D. Ranch - - - - -		800.00
Water pipe and equipment I. D. Bunkhouse - - - - -		300.00
Cesspool I. D. Ranch - - - - -		300.00
Total - - - - -		<u>\$3400.00</u>
