

RESOLUTION OF THE  
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
 PORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session this 5th day of May, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, there has been prepared an advanced estimate of proposed expenditures for the fiscal year 1948 of the Individual Indian Money, White Mountain Apache Tribal Account, which we have carefully examined and considered in connection with the actual needs of our Reservation insofar as it is possible to determine our requirements in advance, and composed of the following sums:

1. Salaries (Judge of Indian Court) - - - - -	\$ 1200.00
2. Per diem Councilmen - - - - -	900.00
3. Stationery and other miscellaneous expenses . . .	600.00
4. Control of Predatory Animals. - - - - -	5000.00
5. Relief for old folks - - - - -	18000.00
6. Round-up wild horses - - - - -	1000.00
7. Tribal Clerk - - - - -	2400.00
8. Care of Club Building, Janitor, Librarian, etc. - -	2400.00
TOTAL - - - - -	\$ 31500.00

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior be requested to approve and the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby recommends and approves the above estimate for the Fiscal Year 1947 as herein presented.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the tribal council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
