

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in regular session this 9th day of June, 1947, that:

WHEREAS, the Council feels the salary paid the Tribal Judge is inadequate and is not compensation commensurate with the responsibilities and duties of the position,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that effective July 1, 1947, the annual salary of the Judge of the Tribal Court shall be \$1,500.00 per year and shall entitle the occupant to such leave of absence as has been heretofore provided by resolution.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on June 9, 1947, by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 18, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 948).
