

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

Be it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that,

WHEREAS, in order to provide a suitable headquarters for the stockman of the recently established Oak Creek Stock Association, that there is hereby authorized the construction of a permanent stock station at Oak Creek. This station is to consist of a house, barn, sheds, storeroom and garage for use of the stockman and storage of supplies and equipment necessary for the proper administration of livestock in the Oak Creek District. There is hereby authorized the expenditure of not to exceed \$10,000.00 of Tribal Funds on deposit to the credit of the Tribe with the Fort Apache Agency for the construction of the Oak Creek Stockman's station.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on September 6, 1947 by a unanimous vote by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
