

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE-TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that,

In order to provide a suitable building for use of the Tribal Court and for Police Headquarters at Fort Apache Agency, that not to exceed \$2000.00 of tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency to the credit of the Tribe is hereby authorized to be expended for the repair, improvement and remodeling of the building at Whiteriver formerly used as a Flour Mill.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10th, 1947, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 18, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 28, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 884).
