

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

So it resolved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that in order to improve the Whiteriver cemetery and provide for better roads to the cemetery that there is hereby authorized to be expended for such cemetery and road improvements the sum of \$950.00, to be paid from funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency to the credit of the tribe.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on November 3, 1947, by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c), of the constitution and by-laws of the tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
