


RESOLUTION .

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


NO. 236

WHEREAS THERE is need of a regular jailer at the Fort Apache Agency jail to properly supervise the jail and prisoners held therein, now

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in special session this 19th. day of January, 1948 does hereby authorize the employment of a full time jailer to work with the police and under the direct supervision of the Deputy Special Officer and said jailer to be responsible to the Deputy Special Officer to supervise the jail and the prisoners held therein. The salary of the jailer shall be \$75.00 per month and shall be paid out of Tribal Court funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency.

The foregoing resolution Number 236 was on January 19, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and none against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 964).
