

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of White Mountain Apache Tribe that

WHEREAS, funds approved in the annual budget for the fiscal year 1948 for expenses of Tribal Council members was not sufficient due to the Council authorizing certain travel expenses not contemplated at the time the budget was prepared and,

WHEREAS, additional funds are needed for Council expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1948 that there be hereby authorized and appropriated from Tribal funds on deposit at the Fort Apache Agency \$200.00 for Council expenses for this fiscal year and in addition, not to exceed \$200.00 for the purpose of purchasing a public address system to be used for Tribal fairs and other Tribal celebrations and outdoor meetings.

The foregoing resolution was on April 5, 1948, duly adopted by a unanimous vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d), of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
