

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
FORT A AGNE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that,

in order to provide funds for salaries of the tribal blacksmith and interpreter for the balance of this fiscal year, there is authorized and appropriated the sum of \$400.00 from tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency for the purpose of paying the salaries of these two positions for the balance of this fiscal year.

The foregoing resolution was on May 6, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 10, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
