PROULDTION OF THE METTE MOUNTAIN APACHE TEIM OF THE FORT ALACRE INDIAN RESERVATION

BC IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the request of the Mavopache Electric Cooperative, Incom Laboride, Arisons to survey for a proposed electric transmission line from the town of Yellary, Arisess in a northerly direction to the morth boundary of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and from a point on the east boundary of the reservation in a southwestorly direction to the town of Maverick is hereby approved, subject to the provisions of 250TR, Test 256.

The foregoing resclution was on September 12, 1948 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the white bountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article Vi. Tection 1(e) of the Constituion and By-laws of the tribe, ratified by the fribe on August 15, 1988 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 28, 1988 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 ftat. 964).
