

RESOLUTIONS

WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE
of the
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation that, an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 of tribal funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Agency be made available as required to provide operating capital for the Apache Mercantile Company according to the approved Plan of operation approved by the office on July 16, 1948.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted on December 3, 1948 by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 16, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 824).
