RADA LUTION OF THE WHITE BEUNTAIN APACHT TRIBE OF THE FURT APACHE INDIAN RECERVATION

BE IT REALITION by the Council of the Thite Mountain Apache Tribe that since the water supply for the Canyon Day Water System authorized by funds provided in Resolution No. 292, is not adequate, authorization for the drilling of additional wells from funds provided for the system is hereby granted, PROVIDED that in the event an adequate water supply is obtained and additional funds are required to complete the installation of the community water system, then the Council will provide the necessary funds from Tribal funds not otherwise obligated.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 16, 1950 duly edopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Fribal Council of the White Mountain apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by article VI. Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Fribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Decretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
