

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Indian Reservation in meeting assembled this 8th day of January, 1951 that the Chairman of the Tribal Council be employed by the Tribe on a full time basis and be paid a salary of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per month beginning on January 9, 1951, with the same privileges of annual and sick leave as are applicable to Government employees, his duties and responsibilities to be set forth in writing and approved by the Tribal Council on or before March 15, 1951.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the salary will be paid from funds made available by the Council for Council expenses.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 8, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 3 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 20, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 501).
