


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe believes that the interest of members of the tribe will be better served by providing that cattle from the tribal herd may be loaned to members on a repayment in kind plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a program for selling cattle to individual members of the tribe to provide for repayment in kind is hereby authorized.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the plan of operation and pertinent forms for the repayment cattle program are attached hereto and made a part of this resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 3, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 934).
