## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that application of Pat Gruwell for assignment of the timber contract covering the Lost Tank Canyon Timber Unit approved August 23, 1950 and authorized by Tribal Resolution No. 50-27 to the J. M. Krauss Lumber Company of Snowflake, Arizona is hereby approved providing said assignment meets with the approval of the Area Director and that satisfactory bond is furnished by the J. M. Krauss Lumber Company.

The foregoing Resolution was on April 3, 1951 duly adopted by a vota of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
