

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Apache Reservation that, the memorandum agreement among the Arizona Game and Fish Commission, Bureau of Indian Affairs and Fish and Wildlife Service for the operation of the Williams Creek Fish Hatchery on the Fort Apache Reservation which was approved by the respective parties in 1946 is hereby approved for the year beginning July 1, 1950 in accordance with Section 13 of the agreement.

The foregoing Resolution was on January 8, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
