RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TYPE OF THE PORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the Fort Abadne Reservation that, the memorandum agreement among the Arizona Game and Fish Commission, Eureau of Indian Affairs and Fish and Middlife Service for the operation of the Milliams Creek Fish Hatchery on the Fort Abadne Reservation which was abbroved by the respective parties in 1946 is hereby approved for the year beginning July 1, 1950 in accordance with Section 15 of the agreement.

The foregoing Mesolution was on January 8, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Anache Pribe pursuant to authority vested in it by article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
