

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Cold Gulch Timber Unit be authorized for sale to Howard Penrod, a member of the tribe, under authority contained in Paragraph 61.17, Title 25, Code of Federal Regulations and that the Chairman and the Secretary of the council are hereby authorized to sign the contract covering the sale of said timber in the minimum price of \$6.00 per thousand per gross tree scale.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 9, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
