

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that there is hereby authorized to appropriate the expenditure of not to exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) to pay the expenses of newspaper advertising the Faught Ridge Burn Timber Unit. Such funds to be paid from Tribal Funds on deposit with the Fort Apache Indian Agency.

The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 13, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
