

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Indian Office wishes to negotiate with the Parks Service relative to the Parks Service operating the Kinisno Ruins which has been operated by the Indian Service,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Indian Service is authorized to negotiate with the Parks Service subject to approval of the final agreement by the Tribal Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on the 10th day of September, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
