

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 51-39, adopted by the council on September 11, 1951 be and the same hereby is amended by adding at the end of paragraph 2 thereof another sentence reading as follows:

"Such increase in the chairman's compensation shall apply only to incumbent Nelson Lupe; but for each succeeding chairman the beginning compensation shall be \$200 per month."

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1951 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (a) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1939, pursuant to Section 16 of the act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
