

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that  
the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00)  
be hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in  
the SDA Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency for the  
construction of a foot bridge at Cibecue.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 2, 1953 duly adopted by a vote  
of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain  
Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d)  
of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on  
August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26,  
1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
