

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Civil Service Position No. T.1, Home Economist, GS 7, at the Fort Apache Agency has been financed from tribal funds on deposit in the United States Treasury, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Council to finance this work from its funds on deposit locally, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that a position of Home Economist be established in the roll of positions now being paid from local tribal funds; said position to be equivalent to a Civil Service position in Grade GS-7 as to salary and leave privileges, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the sum of three thousand three hundred dollars (\$3,300.00) be hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the SEA Accounts of the Fort Apache Agency to finance this position for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that Civil Service Position No. T.1 be abolished.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 2, 1953 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and "y-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
