## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

MURISAS, certain typographic errors appear in Resolution No. 54-18 adopted by the Council on June 1, 1954, and

THE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the third paragraph of Resolution No. 54-18 be smended to read as follows:

Fig. It Further Resolved that the funds authorized for the following items in the attached budget shall remain available for expenditure until the respective projects are completed or until efficially cancelled by the Tribal Council: Section III, item (h); Section V., item (i); Section VIID items (o), (d), (g), (k), (l) and (m); Section II, items (b) and (c), and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Section VIII, item (a) be corrected to read "Herd Operation."

The foregoing Resolution was on June 29, 1954 and duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (e) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
