RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- MUPREAU, application has been received to lease certain asbestos mining property on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, such property being identified as Claims 1 through 10 of the Apache Extension as shown on the attached plat, and
- NHERMAS, it is the desire of the Council that all possible returns accrue to the tribe through development of its mining possibilities, and
- DHERMAS, the Council has been advised that advertising for competitive bids in accordance with Title 25 CFR is mandatory, therefore
- BE IT RECOLVED that the Secretary of the Interior is hereby authorized, pursuant to Section 186.2 of Title 25 CPR, to advertise the sale of a mining lease on the above described property, such lands not being needed for farming or agricultural purposes.

The foregoing Resolution was on August 3, 1954 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Wountain Abache Tribe bursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Jection 1 (c) of the Constitution and by-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (4d Stat. 984)
