

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that tribal budget Resolution No. 54-17 be hereby amended to provide for expenditure of the additional sum of three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3500.00) from tribal funds on deposit in an Individual Indian Money Account with the Fort Apache Agency for the following purposes:

1. For replacement of one police pickup truck damaged beyond repair including sale or trade-in of the wrecked vehicle \$1650.
2. For replacement of tribally-owned 2½-ton stake truck including sale or trade-in of present vehicle \$2850.

The foregoing Resolution was on November 1, 1954 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
