## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT AFACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Boar Canyon No. 4 Logging Unit be authorised for sale to Howard Penrod a member of the Tribe under authority of Paragraph 61.17 Title 25 C.F.R. and that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign in concurrence a contrast covering sale of said timber at a minimum price of eight dollars (\$8.00) per thousand feet gross tree scale.
