## WHITE WOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there was inadvertently omitted from the Tribal budget for fiscal year 1956 (Resolution No. 55-18) the position of Recreation Director and the necessary expenses therefor, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the council that the above be restored, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the budget resolution No. 55-18 be hereby amended as follows and the additional sum of seven thousand six hundred ninety dollars (\$7,690.00) be hereby authorized and appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the Treasurer of the United States.

Section V - Community and family improvement

- (h) Salary of Recreation Director, to be equivalent to Government Grade GS-3 \$3190.00
- (1) Expenses and miscellaneous equipment and supplies for \$1500.00 above
- (j) Purchase automobile for recreation director's use \$3000.00 \$7690.00

The foregoing Resolution was on June 6, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (d) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
