## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- MEREAS, on June 22, 1955 bids were spened in the office of the Fort Apache Indian Agency for the sale of emileaive prospecting permits for uranium and associated minerals, in accordance with terms of sale previously approved by the Owneil of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, on Unit No. 1 thereof a bid of \$13,662.93 was submitted by Atomic Ores, Incorporated, of Globe, Arisons and on Unit No. 3 thereof a bid of \$30,550.50 was submitted by the Freet Goophysical Corporation of Albuquerque, New Mexico, no other bids having been submitted, therefore
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Maite Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that the bids submitted by the Atomic Gree, Incorporated and the Frost Geophysical Corporation be accepted and permits be issued in accordance with the terms of the advertisement, and that the Chairman and Secretary of the Souncil are hereby authorised to sign such permits on behalf of the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 11, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Bribal Council of the White Hountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-lams of the Bribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
