

**RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION**

WHEREAS, on June 22, 1955 bids were opened in the office of the Fort Apache Indian Agency for the sale of exclusive prospecting permits for uranium and associated minerals, in accordance with terms of sale previously approved by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, on Unit No. 1 thereof a bid of \$13,062.93 was submitted by Atomic Ore, Incorporated, of Globe, Arizona and on Unit No. 3 thereof a bid of \$30,550.50 was submitted by the Frost Geophysical Corporation of Albuquerque, New Mexico, no other bids having been submitted, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe in regular session that the bids submitted by the Atomic Ore, Incorporated and the Frost Geophysical Corporation be accepted and permits be issued in accordance with the terms of the advertisement, and that the Chairman and Secretary of the Council are hereby authorized to sign such permits on behalf of the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 11, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
