RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Bear Canyon Logging Unit No. 6 be authorized for sale to Howard Penrod, a tribal member under authority of Paragraph 61.17 Title 25 CFR and that the Chairman and Secretary be authorized to sign in concurrence a contract covering sale of said timber at an appraised price that is not less than eight dollars (\$8.00) per thousand board feet gross tree scale for all species.

The foregoing Resolution was on December 5, 1955 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article VI, Section 1 (c) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on August 15, 1938 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on August 26, 1938 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
